Jugopošta contains huge amounts of information on a very complex subject. The purpose of this list, which is a cross between an index in alphabetical order, and a list of contents, is to enable members to access articles they need, either from their own holdings of Jugopošta or from the group's library. Accordingly, items are usually listed under the headings found in the catalogues with which collectors will be familiar, and attention has been given to chronological order. Inevitably some items fit in two or more categories, and are sometimes listed twice.

What is presented is essentially a complete list of the contents of Jugopošta from Issue Number 1 of September 1984 to Issue Number 117 of March 2016. New issue notes are omitted as these are now listed in the catalogues. Editorial items, society news and a few items of transient interest have not been listed. Occasionally the original title gives little clue as to the contents. In these cases I have added a title. Italicised text in the listing is an explanatory addition to the original title.

Items from 'Members questions and answers' do not usually have titles. Where this is the case I have tried to indicate the nature of the discussion in the list entry, which is usually indicated by (Q &A). These brief items often contain real gems and show the depth of knowledge of contributors. If they are sometimes in the wrong place it reflects the compiler's lack of such knowledge. A few questions which elicited no response have been omitted.

Any system of classification is open to criticism and that is especially true where a topic is as complicated as the stamps and postal history of what used to be Yugoslavia. There is always another way of doing anything, but I hope this is both useful and informative.
